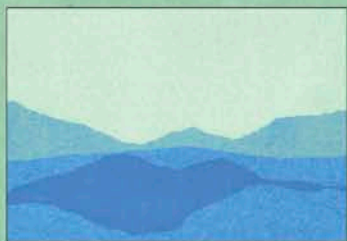
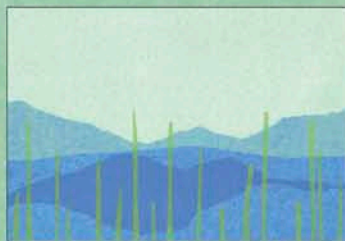


Tissue paper flowers

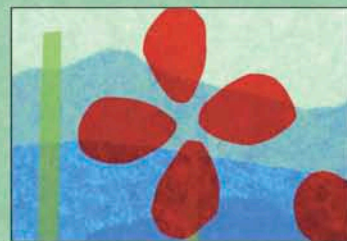
CARTRIDGE PAPER OR WHITE CARDBOARD



1. Rip some strips of blue tissue paper. Glue them across a piece of paper, making them overlap.



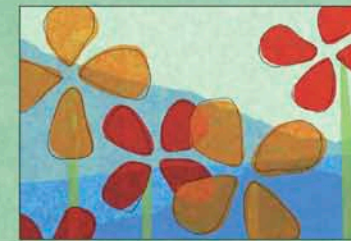
2. Cut some thin strips of green tissue paper for the stems and glue them at the bottom of the paper.



3. Cut out some red petals. Glue four petals around the top of some of the stems.



4. Cut out some orange petals. Glue them around other stems, overlapping some of the red petals.



5. Use a thin felt-tip pen to draw a line around each petal. It doesn't need to be too accurate.



6. Draw a small circle in the middle of each flower, then add two or three lines to each petal.

These flowers also have outlines drawn along their stems.
